OPENING OF CHAPTER

The first day of 34th General Chapter started today with the celebration of the Holy Mass in the church of the General House, presided over by the Superior General Father Michele Perniola. The 33 delegates gathered around the beautiful alter. The celebration was streamed with the help of Mass media. Thanks to the young operators of the Cathedral of Bari.

PRESIDENCY OF THE CHAPTER

Among the first chapter acts was the election of the Presidential Council. Brother Ruggero Valentini (President) and Brother Stefano Caria (Secretary) were elected; Appolinaire Anguissa, Brother Aldo Genova and Father Michael Sebastian were elected as moderators. Finally, Fr. Kingsley Chimaobi and Fr. Joji Babu Tommandru were elected as Scrutinizers.

FUNERAL RITE FOR FATHER GIUSEPPE. For a circumstance desired by Providence today was also celebrated the funeral of Father Giuseppe Donzello, an eighty-year-old Montian religious, who died in Rome on 10th Saturday. He was born in Ispica (Ragusa) where he will be buried in the family tomb. Among his activities are remembered in particular the years of mission in Cameroon and Equatorial Guinea and in the retirement home II Pigneto in Velletri.

FATHER CIARDI ON FOUNDER In the afternoon, the Claretian religious Fr. Fabio Ciardi, a scholar of consecrated life, gave a talk on the figure and role of the founder in a religious Congregation. He developed some basic concepts: a Spirit-guided experience, a luminous idea, an effective work, a transmitted experience. The legacy of the Founder, then, passes through four verbs: to live, to preserve, to deepen, to develop. Finally, he outlined the contribution of individual members to the common charism, the task of the community, the presence of a more articulated charismatic family that includes the laity, harmony with the whole Church. The Founder, therefore, is a saint to imitate, to follow, to listen, to love, to invoke.
